(DEANSHIP OF CONTINUING EDUCATION & COMMUNITY SERVICE POLICY)

Policy Purpose: In order to (1) clarify the actual responsibilities for community service and (2) bring the university policy into compliance with university structure, the following policy has been created to formally align the Bylaws with university practice.

Introduction

Community service is a fundamental part of the mission of Al Yamamah University, and in order to have the “practice” match the “policy” the following change is instituted in the bylaws of YU.

Policy Content

The Deanship of Continuing Education & Community Service is the primary community training program which focuses on short- and mid-term training and education programs in service to the greater Riyadh region. Beyond the technical training and education services provided by the Deanship, other community services are formally housed in the Marketing & Public Relations Department, in coordination with the Deanship of Admissions, Registration and Student Affairs, as well as other university departments. For example, volunteer services by students outside the campus, career day, participation in seminars by employees, blood donation drives, etc. are community services to be organized and managed by the Marketing & Public Relations Department.

This policy is effective April 1, 2012.

Exceptions

The University Council reserves the right to decide on any situation/circumstances outside the conditions stated in this policy.
