(EMBA ADVISORY COUNCIL POLICY)

Introduction

With the addition of the EMBA program at Al Yamamah University, and in an effort to ensure its currency, the University has created the EMBA Advisory Council to provide independent advice on the program and its elements to the Dean and the College of Business Administration.

Policy Content

The EMBA Advisory Committee is charged to review the EMBA program, under the direction of the Dean of the College of Business Administration, in order to ensure that the program structure, curriculum, individual course outlines, faculty qualifications, course satisfaction surveys, program satisfaction surveys, and entering student expectations are consistent with (1) the stated goals and objectives of the program, (2) international standards, and (3) YU and COBA strategic plans.

The Advisory Committee is comprised of:

- Dean of COBA - Chair**
- Director of EMBA**
- Advisor to the President**
- YU EMBA faculty member**
- Non-YU (local) EMBA faculty member**
- International partner faculty member**
- Business/Industry member.**

The Advisory Council meets once each semester to review the program. The Director of the EMBA program files an Annual Report, in consultation with the Advisory Council, with the Strategic Planning Committee.

The University Council reserves the right to decide on any situation/circumstances outside the conditions stated in this policy.
