

Policy on Payment of Fees for External Review of Request for Faculty Promotion

Ministry of Higher Education regulations indicate that candidacies for promotion in academic rank at private educational institutions must be reviewed by the scientific council of a public (government) university.

Given that fees for these services are typically charged by the cooperating university, this policy statement outlines YU's approach to defraying any related costs.

Policy Statement

Faculty candidates for promotion in academic rank at Al Yamamah University shall be personally responsible for the payment of all fees charged by the cooperating public institution for the evaluation conducted by its scientific council.

In practice, YU will make the related payments to the cooperating university. The charge, which will be applied to the candidate's account, will be reduced by 25% annually, such that those who continue on in the employment of Al Yamamah University for an additional four years after the review will owe nothing.

A candidate for promotion whose application is denied by the scientific council will be required to pay all fees for any subsequent review in advance.

Exceptions

The University Council reserves the right to decide on any situation/circumstances outside the conditions stated in this policy.
