### **General Conditions for Sheikh Mohammad Bin Ibrahim Al-Khudeir Grants**

1. The student must hold a high school certificate from Saudi Arabia or an institution recognized by the Ministry of Education, and the certificate must be attested or equivalent and meet the grant requirements at the university.
2. The student must have completed the language preparation phase and at least 30 academic credit hours at Al Yamamah University with a cumulative GPA of no less than 3.3 out of 4.00.
3. Combining two grants at the same time or transferring from one grant to another is not permitted, regardless of the student's GPA. The student should also not be a recipient of any other scholarship from any educational institution in Saudi Arabia.
4. The student should not have been previously expelled from any educational institution in Saudi Arabia.
5. The grant period is four years (equivalent to eight main semesters) for programs like Business Administration, Law, Computer Engineering, and Information Systems, and five years (equivalent to ten main semesters) for Architecture and Interior Architecture majors.
6. The educational grants do not cover summer semesters.
7. Grants are allocated to programs with a lower number of students as determined by the committee.
8. Applications open at the beginning of the second semester each year, and the committee meets after the second semester to review applications and announce accepted students at least one month before the academic year starts.
9. Non-Saudi students must have legal residency in Saudi Arabia.
10. The student must submit an official application for the grant when applications open.
11. Students must comply with university rules, as well as behavioral and ethical standards required by university life.
12. Students must register for a minimum of 15 academic hours per semester, which may include practical training hours.
13. The student must agree to the required cumulative GPA necessary for the continuation of the scholarship.
14. The university reserves the right to withhold or cancel the scholarship if deemed appropriate by the grant committee.
15. The university may suspend the scholarship if the student discontinues their studies in any semester, though the grant committee may make exceptions.
16. Educational grants do not include cooperative training courses.

### **Conditions for Receiving a 40% Tuition Reduction Scholarship**

1. The student applying for the grant must have completed at least 30 academic credit hours.
2. The student should not have failed any course during their studies at the university.
3. The student's cumulative GPA must be 3.60 or higher out of 4.00.
4. To continue receiving the 40% scholarship, the student must maintain a GPA of 3.60 throughout their studies. If the GPA falls below 3.60, the student will be moved to the 20% scholarship (provided they meet the requirements) or the scholarship will be automatically canceled.

5. Students applying for the grant are accepted based on merit and the number of available seats.

### **Conditions for Receiving a 20% Tuition Reduction Scholarship**

1. The student applying for the grant must have completed at least one academic year or 30 academic hours.
2. The student should not have failed any course during their studies at the university.
3. The student's cumulative GPA must be 3.30 or higher out of 4.00.
4. To continue receiving the 20% scholarship, the student must maintain a GPA of 3.30 throughout their studies. If the GPA falls below 3.30, the scholarship will be automatically canceled. If the GPA rises to the required level, the student may reapply for the scholarship.
5. Students applying for the grant are accepted based on merit and the number of available seats.

### **Provisions for Scholarship Suspension**

1. The university reserves the right to withhold or cancel the scholarship if deemed appropriate by the grant committee.
2. The university may suspend the scholarship if the student discontinues studies in any semester, though the grant committee may make exceptions.
3. The scholarship may be reconsidered for students who failed to maintain their GPA for two consecutive semesters if they subsequently achieve the required GPA, subject to the availability of scholarships. The student will need to pay regular university fees until the scholarship is reinstated.
