## Policy on Admission to the WSU PGS Diplomas

Regularly admitted EMBA, MBA, MHRM, and MSIS students already have the option to enroll in the WSU PGD program, along with honors baccalaureate students enrolled at YU. This policy is designated to expand the categories of eligible individuals who may wish to take advantage of the WSU-YU Postgraduate Diploma options.

1. YU EMBA, MBA, MHRM and MSIS students and alumni may choose to take a second or third WSU PGD as part of their continuing education and professional development and certification, with the addition of the credits to their existing transcripts.
2. Members of the Riyadh business community, who might otherwise be eligible to enter one of the PGS master's programs (holder of at least a baccalaureate degree) and who meet the YU admission requirements, especially as relates to English and relevant foundation courses (if necessary) may enroll for credit and a PGD from WSU.
3. Students admitted under the above two conditions would be considered visiting students and would pay the normal tuition/fees (plus admission fee for non-registered visiting PGS students, but not alumni), and must complete the normal YU-WSU PGD four course program. Special students IDs will be allotted tot the visiting students

### Exception

The University-Council reserves the right to decide any situation/ circumstances outside the conditions stated in this policy
